## Office Memorandum

Sub: Order dated 04th September, 2018 & 13th September, 2018 passed by the Hon'ble National Green tribunal, New Delhi in O.A. No. 173 of 2018 & O.A. No. 186 of 2016 in the matters titled "Sudarsan Das Vs State of West Bengal & Ors" & "Satendra Pandey Vs Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change & Anr." respectively—regarding.

This is with reference to the recent orders of the Hon'bie NIST dated 04th September, 2018 in the matter titled Sudarsan Das Vs State of West Bengal & Ors & and order dated 13th September, 2018 in the matter Satendra Pandey Vs Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change & Anr. Copies of the orders are enclosed herewith for ready reference.

- The Hon'ble NGT vide order dated 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 in O.A. No. 186 or 2016 (Satendra Pandey Vs Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change & Anr.) has inter-alia directed as follows:-
  - "(I) Providing for EIA, EMP and therefore, Public Consultation for all areas from 5 to 25 ha falling member Category B-2 at par with Category B-1 by SEAC/ SIEAA as well as for cluster situation wherever it is not provided
  - (ii) Form-1M be made more comprehensive for areas of 0 to 5 ha by dispensing with the requirement for Public Consultation to be evaluated by SEAC for recommendation of grant EC by SEIAA instead of DEAC/DEIAA
  - (iii) if a cluster or an individual lease size exceeds 5 ha the EIA/EMP be made applicable in the process of grant of prior environmental clearance;
  - (N) EIA and/or EMP be prepared for the entire cluster in terms of recommendation 5 (supra) of the Guidelines for the purpose of recommendations 6, 2 and 8 thereof;

- to levise the procedure to also incorporate procedure with respect to applied frace of replendament and timeframe for replendament and timeframe for replendament after mining closure in an area;
- or the MoEF&CC to prepare guidelines for calculation of the cost of restitution or damage caused to mined-out areas along with the Net Present Value or Ecological Services forgone because of illegal or unsciontific minings.
- In view of the above, the undersigned is directed to forward the copy of the aforementioned order for necessary compliance and inform the Ministry about the action taken.
