Order

The necessity for framing of a standardized 'Unified Schedule of Rates' (USoR) for execution of works in the Irrigation & Waterways Department is being felt for quite some time due to various anomalies detected in the existing Schedule of Rates of the Circle offices being followed in different districts.

To bring an infirmity in the determination of standardized Schedule of Rates, it has been decided to constitute a Directorate Level *Schedule of Rates Revision Committee* for formulating an "Unified Schedule of Rates" (USoR) comprising item rates of special category only, which are usually required for execution of works in this Department, by adopting the same procedure and similar methodology as has been adopted in the Public Works Department.

The Directorate level 'Schedule of Rates (SoR) Revision Committee' is hereby being constituted with the following composition:

The Terms of Reference (ToR) of the 'Schedule of Rates Revision Committee' would be as below:

- 1.(a) All Item Rates for works involved in construction of buildings, sanitary & plumbing works and Electrical works, bridges, hydraulic structures etc. including issue rates of cement, steel etc. specifications thereof required for framing of all categories of estimates/DPRs would henceforth have to be compulsorily taken from the current Schedule of Rates (SoR) of Public Works Department, Government of West Bengal, in respect of all such items rates for which are available in the SoR of PW Department. Hence these items need not be included in the 'USoR' of this Department.
- (b) Accordingly, the Committee would undertake the task of revision of item rates for only such items which are required for typical nature of schemes/works undertaken by this Department and are not covered in the standardized 'SoR' of PW Department, by adopting the usual standard operating procedure and norms of analysis including specifications as those of PWD. These items would primarily include but not limited to earthwork in embankment, excavation /

re-excavation / de-siltation of rivers / channels / canals by manual or mechanical means, all sorts of protection works, river training works and canal lining works and civil / structural components of hydraulic structures, excluding concrete, reinforcement, brickwork, plaster etc. of such structures, which are available in the Schedule of Rates (SoR) of Public Works Department.

- (c) While arriving at rates of items in the Departmental 'USoR', reflection of regional variations should be made in district wise clusters, in the same manner as is being followed in the 'SoR' of PW Department.
- (d) In case of overlapping of items of similar nature included in the 'SoR' of PW Department, but rates of which are required to be incorporated in the Departmental USoR, either due to change in specification, or due to difference in purpose or mode of execution, rates of such items should not exceed the ceiling limit of prevailing rates in the current SoR of PW Department.
- 2. The committee would submit the 'Unified Schedule of Rates' (USoR), complete in all respects to the Secretary of this Department within a maximum of 3 (Three) months from the date of issuance of this order.
- 3. The committee would obtain requisite data verified by engineer officers from different districts and any other data, records, analysis of rates etc. needed for finalization of this comprehensive 'USoR'.
- 4. Issue rates of construction materials, if available in the SoR of PWD would be uniformly followed in the Departmental "USoR".
- 5. It is suggested that profit & overhead components, labour welfare cess, reimbursable service-tax and others statutory taxes and charges as may be required to arrive at a justified item rate may be incorporated following the standardized guidelines adopted by PWD, comprising the Rules & Acts of State Finance Department, Labour Department and Departments/Ministries of Government of India.
- 6. The committee members would be functioning during this period in addition to their original duties. The members may visit any of the districts for which TA & DA charges as applicable would be reimbursed from the parent offices on actuals.
- All officials concerned in the Department would extend full and timely corporation to the committee for completion of its task within time. Any delay or reluctance from field officers to submit requisite information sought by the committee will be viewed adversely.
