Agenda: Short listing of new State Plan Projects decided in the Departmental allocation for inclusion under Core State Plan pertaining to jurisdiction of Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project during the current financial year of 2017-18.

Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project and other officers remained present.

The following were discussed:

- 1. The meeting was conducted on the basis of technically sanctioned DPR of schemes submitted by the Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project in conformity with the allocation made on 6th February 2017 in the meeting chaired by Hon'ble MIC inclusive of infrastructure development related works.
- 2. It was stated by Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project that there is no duplication of any proposal with other sources of funding. All the schemes have been selected on the basis of prioritised list of projects decided by him based on ground requirements.
- 3. The committee scrutinised the two infrastructure development related DPRs referred under SI No. 4 & 5 of the <u>Annexure</u> and advised the Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project to provide 'Landscape development drawings' comprising artists impression of proposed beautification & campus development plan, elevation etc. for processing of formal administrative approval. (2nd Mile Sevoke Road and Oodlabai campus infrastructure development schemes).
- 4. Finally, a total of 6 schemes under jurisdiction of Chief Engineer, Teesta Barrage Project at an aggregate cost of ₹ 26.43 crore were approved by the DSC for taking up out of Core State Plan Budget of this Department during the current financial year of 2017-18. Suitable phasing of expenditure would be decided as per budgetary allocation spread over 2017-18 and 2018-19.
- 5. The list of schemes cleared by the Departmental Screening Committee is enclosed.
