Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer (West), Chief Engineer (South West) and other officers remained present.

The following were discussed:

1. Technically sanctioned DPR of 11 new schemes at an aggregate estimated cost of Rs 31.86 Crore, were placed before the DSC more or less in conformity with the allocation fixed in the Departmental meeting taken by Hon'ble MIC on 06.02.2017.
2. All the schemes have been reportedly tendered. Name of the scheme relating to improvement of main canal by lining of Ramchandrapur Irrigation Scheme....under Purulia Construction Division had to be modified, and as such a fresh tender shall be invited after cancellation of the first e-tender.
3. Thus, all the 11 schemes were discussed and cleared in the meeting with minor corrections.
4. Chief Engineers certified that there is no duplication of proposal with other sources of funding. All the schemes have been selected on the basis of ground requirements.
5. Finally all the 11 schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 31.86 crore were approved by the DSC for inclusion under Core State Plan Budget of this Department during the current financial year of 2017-18. Tenders may be invited immediately.
