Sub: Handing over the charges of the jurisdiction of Hooghly Irrigation Division under Western Circle-I to Lower Damodar Irrigation Division under Damodar Irrigation Circle.

In continuation of this Department Memo No.1628(2)–IE dated 02.07.2018 and in partial modification of the Notification No.12-W/2017-18 dated 8<sup>th</sup> August 2017, the undersigned is directed to state the following:

- (a) Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision under Hooghly Irrigation Division does not seem to have any involvement in the externally aided “West Bengal Major Irrigation & Flood Management Project” (WBMIFMP), hence it has been decided that the said Subdivision would retain its normal jurisdiction.
- (b) As Mundeswari Irrigation Subdivision will perform dedicated functioning in the abovesaid project under the Hooghly Irrigation Division, already declared as a *District Project Implementation Unit* (DPIU), Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision will further take over the responsibility of normal works (other than project works) within the territorial jurisdiction of Mundeswari Irrigation Subdivision, until further order.
- (c) In order to facilitate performing of abovesaid function by the Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision effectively, the following personnel of the Mundeswari


Irrigation Subdivision are placed to the disposal of the Assistant Engineer, Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision on deployment basis, until further order.

(d) Executive Engineer-I, Lower Damodar Irrigation Division will be the controlling officer of the Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision (including the personnel placed on deployment from Mundeswari Irrigation Subdivision), in regard to normal works under Capital, Revenue and other sources of funding including SDRF and the said Executive Engineer will exercise budgetary, financial and audit control over the routine functioning in regard to normal field works (other than the works under WBMIFMP) by the Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision, within its own jurisdiction as well as in the jurisdiction of Mundeswari Irrigation Subdivision. As such, the Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision is considered under deemed deployment to the Lower Damodar Irrigation Division, until further order.

(e) However, the administrative control of the Arambagh Irrigation Subdivision, together with the personnel of Mundeswari Irrigation Subdivision would continue to remain under the Executive Engineer, Hooghly Irrigation Division, so far as the matter of Salary, other allowances, Leave, ACR/APR, etc. are concerned.
