MEMORANDUM

The drainage channels in Kolkata and its adjoining municipalities and other urban agglomerations, are being looked after by 8 (eight) working divisions of 3 (three) circles of Irrigation & waterways Directorate. In most of the cases, the work jurisdictions of the aforesaid divisions are not continuous and in some cases, spread across more than one district. It is even seen that a division is having an isolated jurisdiction in the northern part of North 24-Parganas, whereas the major part of the work jurisdiction of the said division falls within South -24 Parganas. A lot of inconvenience are being faced by the Departmental officers in adequately attending the sites of ongoing works and also in planning for future works. Sometimes, this erratic and discontinuous distribution of work jurisdictions make a lot of confusion among the district administrations, concerned local bodies etc. with regard to emergent communications particularly during monsoon period.

2. In view of above, it was decided by the Department to reorient the work jurisdictions among the aforesaid 8 divisions, so that a particular drainage system along with its pumping stations comes under the purview of a division and the work jurisdiction of any division remains within a district, as far as possible. Accordingly, a departmental memorandum was brought out vide No-304-IE/IE-3M-100/2013(Pt-III) dated 28.01.2019 reorienting the work jurisdictions of 8 (eight) working divisions of Irrigation & Waterways Directorate in Kolkata, North 24-Parganas & South 24-Parganas.

3. To facilitate effective implementation of the aforesaid government order, a meeting was held on 05.02.2019 under the chairmanship of the Secretary at Jalasampad Bhawan. It was decided to revise the jurisdiction distribution of the earlier order, particularly relating to SAMD Part-I & Bagjola Canal system. Some anomalies in the lengths of some canals in the Annexure of previous order, are also required to be rectified.

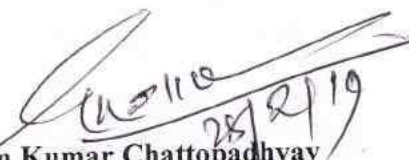
4. Accordingly it has been decided to bring out a fresh order of reorientation of work jurisdictions, modifying the earlier order. The jurisdiction change of Bidhyadhari Drainage Division is not required. The new work jurisdictions of other 8 (eight) divisions is as enclosed as Annexure-I.

5. The handing over and taking over of the revised work jurisdictions will take effect from 01.04.2019 in the manner, stated herein under:

- a. All the divisions will make payments against ongoing works including AMCs to the contractors on the allotments made to them during the current financial year i.e. 2018-19. Thereafter, the documents, MBs, LBs, etc related to balance works are to be handed over to the division to which work jurisdiction is assigned in this order. The residential quarters, godown, pumping stations area also to be handed over in the manner stated at Annexure-I after 01.04.2019.
- b. All the documents, DPRs relating to proposed new works of 2019-20 (Phase-I) are to be prepared and submitted by the respective divisions for their existing jurisdictions to the department, as per the schedule fixed in the review meeting taken by the Hon'ble Minister-in-Charge/Irrigation & Waterways Department on 28.12.2018. The said document's, DPRs and related information, are to be handed over to the divisions thereafter, in case the jurisdiction pertaining to any DPR is newly assigned to that division.

This order supersedes the previous order No-304-IE/IE-3M-100/2013(Pt-III) dated 31.01.2019

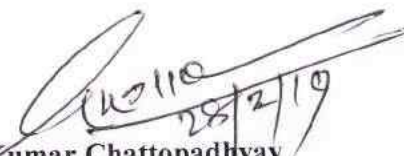

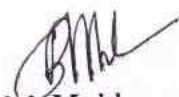
