Sub: Submission of DPR for accordance of Administrative Approval under SDS (Voted) Budget of this Department in conformity with the approved Phase-II allocation during 2019-20,

The undersigned is directed to enclose herewith the approved Phase-II allocation among the Chief Engineers of this Department under Core Sector capital head of State Development Schemes budget during current financial year of 2019-20.

The part (A) of allocation is only for implementation of committed schemes where the allocation is to be adjusted based on actual estimated costs and savings if any cannot be utilised for including any new work.

The part (B) of allocation comprises an aggregate sum of Rs. 332 crore distributed among the Chief Engineers to be identified by them based on ground level priorities and the balance sum of Rs. 130 crore shall have to be finalised based on demands of the public representatives to be identified by the Department.

The part (C) of allocation amounting to Rs. 200 crore would be made to the Chief Engineers by the Department after monsoon of 2019 is over.

It is desirable that the technically sanctioned copies of DPR based on the above allocation should be submitted by the Chief Engineers to the Secretariat office latest by 30th September, 2019 so that the process of according clearance of DSC and administrative approval may be initiated from September itself and tenders invited well before the start of post monsoon working season of 2019-20.
