## Records of discussions in the 4th meeting of the Departmental Committee held on 15.06.2021, constituted by IWD Order No. 02-W/2021-22 dated 4<sup>th</sup> June 2021

Chief Engineer (South) has sought permission to accord approval for floating of short notice e-tenders for 17 no. emergent works under Kakdwip Irrigation Division of total tender value Rs. 1067.17 lakh. Value of work ranges between Rs 25.19 lakh and Rs 99.31 lakh. He has also provided justifications for such short notice tenders. e-tender notice periods proposed for all the 17 no. of works is for 4 days. Chief Engineer (South) and concerned Superintending Engineer Eastern Circle explained the necessity of taking up these works on urgent basis so that embankment core of the restoration work is completed before next spring tide due on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2021, and the total work is completed within 30 days. Two works of values within Rs 30 lakh are targeted to be completed within 21 days and rest of the works having higher values are targeted to be completed within 30 days.

- 2. It is also reported by the Visiting Departmental Inspection Teams that they have visited the worksites on random basis, and have recommended taking up works at these locations. Considering the urgency to stop ingress of saline water at damaged locations before the next Full Moon high tide on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2021, the Committee is hence recommending floating of short notice e-tender for these works, as proposed by the Chief Engineer (South).
- 3. Further, keeping in view the spirit of urgency, the Committee also recommends that in case of disqualifying any bidder for not having adequate credential, the time for registering grievance to the next Appellate Authority is reduced to 24 hours, in lieu of the usual period of 72 hours.
- 4. As already concurred to by the Finance Department, brief referral advertisements in Newspapers may be done directly by the TIA at rates approved by I & CA Department, either directly to the newspapers or through the agencies.
- 5. As already concurred to by the Finance Department, effectiveness of undertaking emergent restoration works through spot bids /offline short notice tenders up to value Rs 20 lakh in each case, is recommended to be reckoned from 26<sup>th</sup> May 2021 (the date of landfall of Yaas), instead of 1<sup>st</sup> June, in terms of I & WD Notification No. 19(W)/2016-17 dated 19.07.21. These relaxations would be in force till 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021.
