Agenda: Recommendation of new prioritized schemes as a part of the holistic plan for improvement of drainage system within the KMC area for inclusion under Core State Development Schemes (Voted) budget of Irrigation & Waterways Department during the current FY of 2021-22.

Secretary took the chair.

The following were discussed:

1. DPR of 2 (two) no. of new projects having an aggregate estimated cost of Rs. 13.26 crore as detailed in the <u>Annexure</u> to this order were placed before the Departmental Screening Committee for consideration. The schemes were prioritized under the Comprehensive Master Plan under preparation for holistic rejuvenation of the drainage system in conformity with the discussions held recently between Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department, Kolkata Municipal Corporation, Kolkata Metropolitan Development

Authority and Irrigation & Waterways Department and the High Level meeting held on 18.06.2021 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal regarding the issues of water logging in Kolkata and its related remedial measures.

- 2. Both the schemes have been technically vetted by the concerned Chief Engineer (South), Irrigation & Waterways Directorate and finally technically recommended by the Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers in the 282nd meeting held on 07.10.2021.
- 3. Each of the schemes have estimated cost above Rs. 1.50 crore and hence is beyond the power for administrative approval delegated to this Department by the Finance Department vide their Memorandum No. 1971-F(Y) dated 30.06.2021.
- 4. After a threadbare deliberation, both the schemes having an aggregate estimated cost of Rs. 13.26 crore as per <u>Annexure</u> to this order were cleared by the DSC and recommended for inclusion under Core State Development Schemes budget of I&WD under Demand No. 32, B.P no 18 during the current FY 2021-22. Formal proposals for administrative approval are required to be submitted to the Finance Department.
- 5. Permission is hereby accorded to the Chief Engineer (South) and the TIA for floating of tender immediately. However, last date of bid submission period in the e-tender shall have to be extended till the time the formal approval is obtained from the Finance Department for which the technically sanctioned DPRs along with budget fitment needs to be processed for relaxation of Finance Department Memorandum No. 1971-F(Y) dated 30.06.2021.
- 6. This is issued with the approval of the highest authority of this Department.
