Addendum Order

A "Directorate Level Technical Committee" (DLTC) was constituted for undertaking independent technical scrutiny of all new capital works projects having estimated costs upto value of Rs. 5.00 Crore to be posed under SDS voted Departmental Budget vide this Departments' Memorandum No. 03-(W)/2021-22 dated 07.07.2021 communicated vide Memo No. 70-IB of even date.

Moreover, the "Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers"(DTCCE), constituted vide Memorandum No. 396-IB/IW/O/IB-MISC-51/2019-20 dated 24.12.2019, examines and scrutinize all new Capital Projects having estimated value more than Rs. 5.00 Crore which are to be funded under SDS voted Departmental Budget (State Core Plan, RIDF etc.)

Now, it has been decided in the Irrigation & Waterways Department that all such high value new Capital Projects having estimated value above Rs. 5.00 Crore, to be funded under State Development Scheme Departmental Budget, will undergo 2-tier checking/ scrutiny before placing the DPRs in the meeting of the "Departmental Screening Committee (DSC) " for clearance.

The Capital Schemes (State Core Plan, RIDF) having estimated value above Rs. 5.00 Crore are to be submitted initially to the "'Directorate Level Technical Committee' (DLTC)" for 1st tier independent technical checking/ scrutiny and after clearance by the DLTC, the Schemes, after compliance of the observations of DLTC, if any, are to be submitted before the "Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers"(DTCCE) for checking technical and economic viabilities of the Schemes. Finally, if cleared by the "Departmental

Technical Committee of Chief Engineers", the Schemes will be submitted to the Department for clearance of the " **Departmental Screening Committee (DSC)** ". In case of Centrally Funded Projects (like FMP, RMBA etc.) the DPRs will be continued to be referred to the " **State Technical Advisory Committee (State TAC)**" instead of "Departmental Screening Committee (DSC) ",after their clearance by the "Departmental Technical Committee of Chief Engineers" as mentioned above.

In case of any technical disagreement between the DLTC and DTCCE, the same will be resolved at the level of DSC or State TAC, as the case may be.

The schemes, to be proposed under RKVY-RAFTAR, are not required to be referred to the " State Technical Advisory Committee (State TAC) ", constituted vide Departmental Memorandum No. 431-IB-IW/O/IB-Misc-51/2019-20(Pt.) dated 14.01.2020 though those are Central Sector Schemes, but such schemes are to be examined at DLTC and DTCCE, in the manner stated in paragraph I and paragraph 4 above depending on the scheme value.

Other contents of the Departments' Memorandum No. 03-(w)/2021-22 dated 07.07.2021 shall remain unchanged.
