- 6. The expenditure to be booked under SDS (Maintenance) during 2023-24. Post facto Administrative Approval through AAFS will be accorded on Tendered Amount plus contingency subject to availability of sufficient commitment (phasing) in AAFS module and release of fund also depends on availability of maintenance fund with this Department during 2023-24.
