2. This e-Procurement notice includes the terms and conditions applicable to submission of quotations; criteria for qualification, evaluation, and for award of contract; and relevant forms to be filled by the bidders. Implementing Agency has not issued a separate RFQ document for this purchase. The e-Procurement notice including the terms and conditions etc. can be downloaded free of cost by logging on to the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in>. The bidders would be required to register in the website which is free of cost.
3. For submission of Quotation, the Bidder is required to have Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the Certifying Authorities authorized by Government of India for issuing DSC. Bidders can see the list of licensed CA's from the link (www.cca.gov.in). Bidders who have not obtained the user ID and password for participating in e-procurement in this Project, may obtain the same from the website: <https://wbtenders.gov.in>.
4. **Quotations shall be submitted on <https://wbtenders.gov.in> on or before 15:00 hours on 23.02.2022.** Any quotation or modifications to quotation received outside e-procurement system will not be considered. Terms and Conditions

1. **Eligibility:** A Bidder(a) shall not participate in more than one Quotation; (b) shall not have conflict of interest as defined in the Bank's Procurement Guidelines; and (c) should not have been (i) temporarily suspended or debarred by the World Bank Group in compliance with the Bank's Anti-Corruption Guidelines and its Sanctions Framework; or (ii) blacklisted or suspended by Government Department/Semi-Government/Public Sector Organization in India.(d) Bids from Joint Ventures are not acceptable.
2. **Clarifications & Amendments:** If the Employer receives any request for clarification of this RFQ Document, it will upload its response together with any amendment to this document, on the e-procurement portal for information of all bidders. Bidders should check on the e-procurement system, for any amendments to the terms and conditions.

3. **The Quotation shall comprise the following:**

The Bid Security of the successful Bidder shall be required to be kept valid and / or validity extended till such time the Performance Security is accepted by the Employer.

The Bid Security may be forfeited:

4. Quotation Prices:

- The contract shall be for the whole of the services, as specified in the Price Quotation Form. Corrections, if any, can be carried out by editing the information before electronic submission.
- The Bidder shall be responsible for meeting all tax liabilities other than Goods and Services Tax (GST) arising out of the Contract.

- (c) GST, which will be payable on the services at the time of invoicing, shall be shown separately.
- (d) The rates quoted by the Bidder shall be fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.
- (e) The Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.
- (f) Each bidder shall submit only one bid.

5. **Qualification of the Bidder:** To qualify for award of the Contract, Bidders shall meet the following minimum qualifying criteria:

(A) Financial Capability:

The average annual financial turnover of intending bidder during last three Financial Years ending 31st March of previous financial year should **not be less than INR 28 (Twenty eighty) lakh**. The bidders have to submit Audited Annual Accounts Reports in support of their Average Annual Financial Turnover. If the bidder does not have Audited Annual Account Report for the last Financial Year, he may submit Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant (applicable only for last Financial Year).

(B) Technical Capability:

Experience of having completed similar works during last 5 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which offers are invited should be either of the following:

- (a) Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to INR 1400000/- Only.
- or
- (b) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to INR 2200000/- Only.

Completed Work means - executed / completed / delivered portion of Work Order / AMC / RC / Purchase Order, Payment receipt documents with ref. to WO No. and date of execution certificate with executed value and referred order no. be also considered as a proof of execution / delivery even if the works / services have not been completed in totality (subject to furnishing proof of executed / supplied value of works / services in the form of certified copies of RA Bills) or any relevant documents, which is sufficient to proof the works / services completed / delivered or to be completed.

Similar Work Means-Topographic, Hydrographic / Bathymetric / Sedimentation Survey Works using latest instruments like TS, RTK, DGPS, ADCP etc

(C) Essential Documents:

The bidders shall have to submit the following documents in order to meet the Qualifying Requirements:

1. Copies of Audited Annual Accounts reports / certificate of Chartered Accountant in support of Financial Capability as stipulated in SL. No. (A).
2. Copy(s) of Credential Certificate(s) in support of Technical Capability as stipulated in SL No (B).

3. Copy of GST Registration Certificate.
 4. Copy of PAN Card.
 5. Copy of Partnership deed / Affidavit of Proprietorship / Article of Association including any change in the constitution business duly attested by a Notary Public.
 6. List of major items of equipment owned by the company and the list of instruments proposed to be utilised for the contract.
 7. Qualifications, experience and no of personnel in the payroll of the company and the key site management and technical personnel proposed for the Contract;
6. **Validity of Quotation:** Quotation shall remain valid for a period not less than **90 days** after the deadline date specified for submission.
7. **Signing of Quotations:** The **name and position** held by each person signing the quotation and related documents must be typed or printed below the signature.
8. **Quotation Submission:** The Letter of Quotation shall be filled, **signed and scanned** copies shall be uploaded along with the Price Schedules that shall be furnished using the Forms available online without any alterations. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested. Scanned copies of all other documents shall also be uploaded on this website.
9. **Deadline for Submission of Quotations:** Quotations must be uploaded online, not later than the deadline for submission of quotations by **15:00 hours on 23.02.2022** as per server time. A Bidder may modify its Quotation any number of times by using the appropriate option on the e-Procurement Portal, before the deadline for submission of Quotations. **Quotations once withdrawn cannot be resubmitted.**
10. **Online Opening and Evaluation of Quotations:** The Quotations will be opened online on the specified date and time. This can also be viewed by the Bidder online, and electronic summary of quotation opening will be generated and uploaded online.
- (a) The Employer shall examine the quotation to determine whether the quotation **(a)** has been properly signed (Clause 7); **(b)** meets the eligibility criteria & qualification criteria (Clause 1 & 5); and **(c)** Price Schedules are in accordance with the requirements specified in the RFQ document.
 - (b) Only Quotations that are both substantially responsive to the RFQ document and meet all Qualification Criteria shall qualify for financial evaluation.
 - (c) The evaluation shall be based **excluding GST and including any other taxes.**
 - (d) Employer shall **notify in writing** those Bidders who have failed to meet the Qualification Criteria or whose Quotations were considered non-responsive to the requirements in the RFQ document, advising them that their Quotation failed to meet the requirements of the RFQ document.

11. **Award of Contract:** The Employer will award the Contract to the Bidder whose quotation has been determined to be **substantially responsive** and who has offered the **lowest evaluated quotation price**

- (a) Notwithstanding the above, the Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to the award of contract.
- (b) Regarding required number of **substantially responsive bidder** ,World Bank's "Guidelines -Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank's Borrowers" Revised July 2014 , may be followed.
- (c) The Bidder whose quotation is accepted will be notified of the award of Contract by the Employer **prior to expiration of the quotation validity period.**
- (d) 100 % payment may be made within 30(Thirty) days of receipt of all deliverables maintaining all specifications, terms & conditions, acceptance of the same, receipt of invoice subject to availability of fund. Payment of GST for the services at the time of invoicing, although already included in the total cost, will be at actual.

12. **Performance Security:** Within 15 days of receiving Letter of Acceptance, the successful Bidder shall deliver to The Executive Engineer, Burdwan Investigation & Planning Division, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal (Employer) the performance security (either a Bank Guarantee or a Fixed Deposit/Term Deposit Receipt in favor of the Employer) for an amount equivalent of **5 (five) % of the contract price**. The Performance Security shall be valid beyond 45 days the contract completion period. Failure of the successful Bidder to furnish performance security and to sign the agreement within the period stipulated shall constitute sufficient grounds for annulment of award and debarring the bidder from participation in bidding for services/works by the Employer for a period of one year, in which case the Employer may make the award to the next lowest evaluated Bidder or seek quotations afresh.

13. Supply of all materials and equipment shall be the responsibility of the Bidder. Employer will not issue any material/equipment.

If the Bidder disagrees with this proposal, the Bidder should so state in the Quotation. If, in the Letter of Acceptance, the Employer has not agreed on the appointment of the Adjudicator, the Adjudicator shall be appointed by the President of the Institution of Engineers, [State] State Centre at the request of either party.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

Background:

West Bengal specially West Medinipur district crisscross with a number of rivers/khals etc. Many of these streams are used for irrigation purpose and others are mainly for drainage channels. These streams often carry flood discharge during monsoon period causing loss of property and human life.

Under this situation it has long been felt that a survey of the embankments under KKB Master Plan and adjacent areas which envisage portion of West Medinipur district, a prime job which needs to be taken up. The survey shall provide a detailed picture of the existing status of the embankments in this area. This data is expected to act as the basic information which when studied shall help in the decision-making process for suitable restoration and strengthening as required. The data so generated by this survey work shall be geo-referenced and the same shall be incorporated in the Web based Integrated Embankment Management System (IEMS) being developed under NHP. Once the survey data as per this contract is available in the GIS based system it will be very useful to formulate and decide the repair / rehabilitation /strengthening/ raising of the embankments at the vulnerable stretches including flood emergency preparedness that needs to be taken up during severe cyclones which this area is highly prone to. The works undertaken and progress including all technical and administrative details of a work on the embankment shall be available in the system with dates for future reference and action. Data in the IEMS system shall be regularly updated from time to time through regular survey and supervision reports by departmental staff / contracts with departmental fund or even by crowd sourcing as and when necessary. It is required to capture time-stamped geotagged photographs showing the sections of the embankment that are (i) weak (ii) have important structures behind (iii) are protected by plantations or have berm for plantation (iv) have structural protection works (v) have ponds behind (vi) any other important feature as decided by the engineer in charge. It is envisaged that the maximum elevation of water attained at critical locations on the embankment with date, and locations of historical breach would also be captured and documented during field survey. These would be integrated with the Embankment Asset Management System being developed under a separate assignment.

The current area considered in this work consists of the embankments under KKB Master Plan in the West Medinipur district of West Bengal.

OBJECTIVES OF PROPOSAL

The main objectives of the proposal in brief are:

- i. Detail topographic survey along Embankments of along various rivers / channels / sea /creek etc involving long section and cross-section at regular intervals, alignment, physical status and assets etc as detailed below
- ii. Capturing details of the Embankment physical status, regulator inlets,(including geotagged and time stamped photographs) bank protection, river training works, locations showing signs of problems like rat burrows, cuts, depressions etc., locations with encroachments, vegetative growth etc and any other sensitive information on embankment etc as per direction of Engineer in Charge, all geo tagged and time stamped.

- iii. Collection of undisturbed Soil samples along embankment up to a depth of 1.5 m @ 1000 M c/c & carriage of same to the Quality Control Lab of I &W Deptt at Ramnagar, dist Purba Medinipur, West Bengal for future laboratory tests (to be carried out separately).
- iv. Digitization of the entire surveyed area including the embankments, and all other information all on GIS platform.
- v. Fixing of DGPS control points and Fixation and Construction of Bench Mark pillars at suitable interval as per direction of Engineer in Charge.
- vi. Generation and submission of hard (at a scale of 1: 4000 or larger, as decided by the engineer in charge) and soft copies of longitudinal (along the centre-line) and cross-sectional plots as per survey specifications Plan view of the embankment along the alignment of the embankment showing all important structures, encroachments, vegetation (mangrove), etc within the zone of survey i.e., 30 M and 50 M on either side of embankment toe, representing riverside and countryside, respectively.
- vii. Submission of the embankment data in standard GIS file format for integration in Embankment Management Software.
- viii. Create visualization and plots for verification.
- ix. Submission of survey completion report.
- x. In-situ geo-technical investigation of soil samples along embankment / bank line of those rivers/khals at suitable intervals

4. SCOPE OF PROPOSAL

The survey is to be carried out using survey instruments like Total Stations, DGPS-RTK, and associated with GPS system to ensure accuracy and Geo-reference and as per instruction of Engineer-in-Charge.

The work shall cover all technical aspects of topographic & hydrographic survey, collection of soil samples for geo technical investigation, etc. which includes the following:

The field survey consists of:

- (i) Topographical survey of centre line of embankment @ 50 M c/c and the top width of the embankment.(accuracy should be ± 2.5 cm vertically and ± 7.5 cm horizontally). However, all points depicting changes/ other important features should be captured in addition.
- (ii) Cross section survey of the embankment @ not exceeding 250 M c/c (extending 50 M beyond country side toe line and 30 M beyond riverside toe line or Low water level whichever is nearer; accuracy should be ± 2.5 cm vertically and ± 7.5 cm horizontally).
- (iii) Survey along the embankment line and along the sides capturing physical features like bank protection (including the type of protection), present status (damaged or not and degree of damage), vegetative growth if any, pond, inlet/outlet structure (With details and

photograph), jetties, hutments etc all within the survey zone of 30 M and 50 M on either side as mentioned above.

- (iv) Collection of undisturbed soil samples @1000 M c/c distance along embankment up to a depth of 1.5 M from top of embankment & carriage of those samples with proper labelling all complete as per IS 2132 (1986) for assessment of different soil properties like unconfined compressive strength (UCS), Specific gravity (G), Liquid limit (LL), Plastic limit (PL), Grain size distribution (by dry and wet method), to the Quality Control Lab of I&W Deptt at Ramnagar, dist Purba Medinipur, West Bengal as per direction of Engineer-in-Charge. The cost of soil sample analysis is to be borne by the department.
- (v) Construction of Bench Mark pillar as per attached specifications at suitable locations (approximately 1BM pillar for every 4 KM) on embankment proper or at places not greater than 100 M from embankment as per direction of the Engineer in charge.
- (vi) Identification of (i) vulnerable locations (ii) locations needing immediate attention and (iii) relatively safer zones of the embankment
- (vii) Conducting in-situ field density test by common balance, field moisture content test by rapid moisture meter, field permeability test by constant head and falling head method [at the depth of 1.5 M from countryside toe of the embankment] @2000 m c/c distance along embankments and **submission of report after getting them certified by reputed Govt. organization / Institute as per direction of Engineer-in-Charge.**

Submission of report shall comprise of the following

- (i) Index map of the surveyed area showing all important features in a suitable scale, all geo referenced.
- (ii) Longitudinal section (along the centre-line) and cross-sectional plots of embankments.
- (iii) Survey map along the alignment of the embankment showing all important features like armoured / unarmoured, houses, inlets/outlet structures, vegetative growth, pond, jetties, eroded zones and similar other important information of importance all geo referenced.
- (iv) List of inlet /outlet structures along with details of type, location etc along with photographs all geo tagged and time stamped.
- (v) Apart from the hard copy of report & drawings (envisaged at a scale of 1:4000 or larger, three copies are to be submitted), soft copies of all survey data are to be submitted as geodatabase as well as kml, Excel and AutoCAD format for records and further analysis and incorporation in integrated embankment management system.
- (vi) Submission of all raw data from digital level shall be submitted along with adjusted and unadjusted levels in tabular form & by using applicable Geo-Office software as per direction of Engineer in- Charge complete
- (vii) DWG& .KMZ/.KML file of the detailed topographic survey of the embankment/ bank shall be made from the survey data such that the layer can be visualized in Google Earth/Arc GIS Earth.
- (viii) Submission of hard copy (3 nos) and soft copies of all shape files and/or geodatabase,

dwgs, maps etc, one each for Project Manager, DDO and Director, Adv Planning

- (ix) In-situ Geo technical soil investigation report certified by reputed Govt. organization/Institute as per direction of Engineer-in-Charge.

The bidder shall furnish the Technical Compliance Sheet as a part of his bid with **supporting documents**; which establishing the bidder's eligibility to bid and his qualification to participate in the bid, without fulfilling the following parameter, the bidder is liable for rejection without arising any reason.

DRAFT CONTRACT AGREEMENT

1. This deed of agreement is made in the form of agreement on _____ day _____ month _____ 20____, between the _____ (Employer) or his authorized representative (hereinafter referred to as the first party) and _____ (Name of the Service Provider), S/O _____ resident of _____ (hereinafter referred to as the second party), to execute the non-consulting services of: **Survey of embankments under KKB Master Plan and corresponding Mapping and Health Checking under NHP of I&W Deptt GoWB.**

(here in after referred to as services) on the following terms and conditions.

2. Contract Price

The total Contract Price for the services (hereinafter referred to as the “total price”) is _____ INR (excluding/including (*Choose one option*) Goods and Services Tax).

2.1. Payments under the Contract

Payments to the second party for the services will be released by the first party in the following manner:

100% Payment to the second party for the works/services will be released by the first party after completion of all works/services as per schedule-specification by maintaining all terms & condition and receipt & acceptance of all deliverables as a whole as per direction & satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge.

2.2 Payments will be made on certification of the invoice by the Engineer-in-Charge with respect to quality/quantity of services executed in the format in **Annexure I**.

2.3 **Engineer-in-Charge/ Project Manager:** The agency shall undertake the survey work of embankments in consultation with The **Executive Engineer, KKB Project Division, who will function as Project Manager** for this work.

3. Notice by Service Provider to Employer

The second party, on the services reaching each stage of execution, issue a notice to the first party or the Project Manager nominated by the first party (who is responsible for supervising the Service Provider, administering the contract, certifying the payments due to the Service Provider, issuing and valuing variations to the contract, awarding extensions of time etc.), to visit the site for certification of stage completion. Within 15 days of the receipt of such notice, the first party or the Project Manager nominated by it, will ensure issue of stage completion certificate after due verification.

3. Completion Time

The services should be completed in **4 (four) months** from the date of this Agreement. In exceptional circumstances, the time period stated in this clause may be extended in writing by mutual consent of both the parties.

5. If any of the compensation events mentioned below would prevent the services being completed by the intended completion date, the first party will decide on the intended completion date being extended by a suitable period:
- (a) The first party orders a delay for execution of the services on time.
 - (b) Ground conditions are substantially more adverse than could reasonably have been assumed before issue of letter of acceptance and from information provided to second party or from visual inspection of the site.
 - (c) Payments due to the second party are delayed without reason.
 - (d) Certification for stage completion of the services is delayed unreasonably.
6. Any willful delay on the part of the second party in completing the services within the stipulated period will render him liable to pay liquidated damages. @ INR 0.05% of the *contract value* per day which will be deducted from payments due to him. The first party may cancel the contract and take recourse to such other action as deemed appropriate once the total amount of liquidated damages exceeds 5 % of the contract amount.

7. Duties and Responsibilities of the First Party

- 7.1 The first party shall be responsible for providing regular and frequent supervision and guidance to the second party for carrying out the services as per description of services. This will include written guidelines and regular site visit of the authorized personnel of the first party, for checking quality of services to ensure that it is as per the norms.
- 7.2 The Project Manager or such other person as may be authorized by the first party shall hold meeting once in a fortnight where the second party or his representative will submit the latest information including progress report and difficulties if any, in the execution of the services. The whole team may jointly inspect the site on a particular day to take stock of activities.
- 7.3 The Project Manager shall record his observations/instructions at the time of his site visit. The second party will carry out the instructions and promptly rectify any deviations pointed out by the Project Manager. If the deviations are not rectified, within the time specified in the Project Manager's notice, the first party as well as the Project Manager nominated by it, may instruct stoppage or suspension of the services. It shall thereupon be open to the first party or the Project Manager to have the deviations rectified at the cost of the second party.

8. Duties and Responsibilities of the Second Party

8.1 The second party shall:

- (a) take up the services and arrange for its completion within the time period stipulated in Clause 2 ;
- (b) employ suitable manpower and equipment to carry out the services;
- (c) regularly supervise and monitor the progress of services;
- (d) abide by the technical suggestions/direction of supervisory personnel designated by the Employer;

- (e) be responsible for bringing any discrepancy to the notice of the representative of the first party and seek necessary clarification;
- (f) ensure that the service is carried out in accordance with specifications, drawings and within the total of the contract amount without any cost escalation;
- (g) keep the first party informed about the progress of services;
- (h) maintain necessary insurance against loss of equipment and property etc. or workman disability compensation claims of the personnel deployed on the services as well as third party claims.
- (i) pay all duties, taxes and other levies payable by service providers' agencies as per law under the contract (First party will effect deduction (TDS) from running bills in respect of such taxes as may be imposed under the law)

8. Variations / Extra Items

The services shall be carried out by the second party in accordance with the approved description of services. However, if, on account of any other factors, variations are considered necessary, the following procedure shall be followed:

- (a) The second party shall provide the Project Manager with a quotation for carrying out the Variation when requested to do so by the Project Manager. The Project Manager shall assess the quotation, which shall be given within seven days of the request before the Variation is ordered.
- (b) If the quotation given by the second party is unreasonable, the Project Manager may order the Variation and make a change to the Contract Price which shall be based on Project Manager's own forecast of the effects of the Variation on the Service Provider's costs.
- (c) The second party shall not be entitled to additional payment for costs which could have been avoided by giving early warning.

10. Securities

The Performance Security (either a Bank Guarantee in the format attached or Fixed Deposit/ Term Deposit Receipt from a Nationalized or Scheduled Bank in India) shall be provided to the Employer no later than the date specified in the Letter of Acceptance and shall be issued in an amount and form and by a bank or surety acceptable to the Employer. 11. Termination

11.1 By the Employer

The Employer may terminate this Contract, by not less than 15 days' written notice of termination to the Service Provider, to be given after the occurrence of any of the events specified below:

- (c) The Adjudicator shall be paid by the hour at the rate specified above together with reimbursable expenses for vehicle hire, food and lodging, if required, as agreed in connection with the adjudication procedure, and the cost shall be divided equally between the Employer and the Bidder, whatever decision is reached by the Adjudicator.
